PO REFRESHER ON TRANSFEMORAL SOCKET DESIGN.

The training on quadrilateral socket for TF prosthesis is a Polypropylene refresher course designed to review the process of casting technique, bench alignment, and fitting with some additional new techniques in order to obtain the consistency quality devices throughout the rehab Centre in Lao. In addition, the Centre could use this opportunity to deliver at least 4 prosthetic devices to clients after the training is completed.

- To standardize the manufacturing process in all Centers
